TRUE REFLECTION

The primary purpose of having a mirror is to enable you to see a reflection of yourself. Based on what we see in the mirror, we may find it necessary to make changes in order to make our appearance acceptable - as the mirror never lies. However, a mirror does not have the ability to reflect the flaws in our character and so the image that we think that we reflect to the world around us is not always our true self.

Truth be told we all have fallen prey to the negative image myths and deception that society pitches and we use all available resources to emulate the latest fashion, trends or popular expectations from our peers and promotions from mass media. So we exploit several disguises, whether it's to get people's approval or that we simply don't feel comfortable revealing our true nature. But as believers we must ask ourselves "What criteria should determine our identity?"

First and foremost, God knows our heart, He knows our true self, our true image and He still loves us! He wants us to look in the mirror and see... Jesus. He wants people to look at us and see... Jesus. He wants one single image being projected by us: JESUS. He wants to destroy all our masks and change our reflection, our inner image. He doesn't want us to do the work by ourselves as we aren't capable of completely changing into Jesus. But we can resemble Him like a child resembles their father or mother. The people of God are not called simply to reformation or even imitation, but rather transformation

10 TRAITS THAT DEFINE OUR TRUE IDENTITY

I. Availability is being willing to adjust our own schedule, agenda, and plans to fit the right desires of God and others. It makes personal priorities secondary to the needs of God and others. It is to reflect God's priorities so we are always available to Him and others when we are serving. (Mark 1:17-18; Acts 16:10)

II. Christlikeness This doesn't mean that we should simply mimic Christ; go where he went, say what he said, do what he did? The call to be like Christ is something more than simply acting like Jesus. It's to have his same drive, goals, ambitions. To have the same Spirit. (Philippians 2:5-8)

III. Courage realizes that God has given us the strength to face any situation, trial, or peril. It is the ability to react, knowing that God is in control, that He who is in me is greater than he who is against me. (Deuteronomy 31:6)

IV. Enthusiasm will enable us to overcome disappointments and setbacks, so we can be positive, optimistic, and keep up our interest, attitude, and zeal, even when things are ominous. (Matthews 5:16)

V. Honesty & Truthfulness mean being straight and honest with others and doing what is right. This trait will allow us to earn trust by being accurate with facts and situations. (2 Cor. 8:21; Ephesians 4:25)

VI. Humility minimizes arrogance and removes pride. It is recognizing our fallen nature and tendency to think we are better than we are, and our striving to lift up ourselves above others and God. Humbleness will enable us to be a teachable person who is willing to have the attitude of submission and servanthood, one who confesses sin and remembers how Christ served us! (1 Peter 3:5)

VII. Love will enable us to appreciate our brothers and sisters in the Lord, and, of



course, our family, and others around us. Love is taking the initiative to build up and meet the needs of others without expecting anything in return. (John 13:1; John 15:13; 1 Corinthians 13:3)

VIII. Purity & Holiness is being set apart for God's use, which is holiness in action. It does not allow us to be contaminated nor interfere with others in our growth and relationship in Christ. (Philippians 4:8; James 4:8)

IX. Obedience is submitting to do what God requires of us. It is also recognizing the authority and direction from others, such as the Pastor, Church Leaders, Supervisors and Teachers, so we can create winning situations. (Prov 19:16; 2 Corinthians 10:5)

X. Servanthood - We live in the era of self. At Work, recognition is given to #1 producer so we've developed an attitude of "by any means necessary" and focus all of our time & efforts on our careers. But we should also aspire to serving our families, giving tithes and offerings, visiting the widows, orphaned, sick, and shut in, sharing our skills & talents to help those in our community or just simply saying a kind word and befriending someone. (John 13:34; Philippians 2:3-4)

Next time you want see your true identity forego your bathroom mirror and go the Word of God. The Bible is the true mirror that we can look at and see our true reflection, no masks, no pretense. And we can see how well we are doing God's will, how well we resemble Jesus. Thank God that He is still working in us to be more conformed to the image of His dear Son. He works all things together for good so that we might be like the Jesus Christ, emotionally, mentally as well as spiritually.

Is your spiritual identity intact? Have the hardships and cares of life or our enemy the devil spiritually stolen your identity? Or, are you experiencing all of the rights and benefits as a child of our heavenly Father?

Identity Theft - the taking of someone's personal identification information - is America's fastest-growing crime and affecting millions of people each year! Thieves use the information of another person without their authority. Unlike fingerprints, which are unique, someone at your expense can steal and misuse your personal information.

Many have struggled and many do struggle spiritually to find their place in this life and to realize their God-given identity. No matter our age, God intended for us to have a deep inner knowledge of who we are in Him. We will never truly fulfill our God-given destiny until we discover our spiritual identity.

Why does the enemy try to steal our identity? We are adopted by God and are being changed into His likeness (Gen 1:26). Have you considered some of the rights and benefits we receive through our identification 'in Christ'...because as believers we are redeemed

(Jeremiah 31:3)

We have a guarantee of your inheritance.
(Ephesians 1:14)

We have access to the Father by one Spirit.
(Ephesians 2:18)

We are a member of the household of God.
(Ephesians 2:19)

We are born of God, and the wicked one does not own.
(1 John 5:18)

In the movie series, 'The Bourne Identity', Jason Bourne had a career. He attained special skills, talents and abilities, but someone stole his identity. He began to live a

tormented life, having no knowledge of his identity. This lack of identification influenced Jason's behavior and caused him to continue searching for his identity. In the end he finds out what and who he is. In contrast, the prodigal son knew who he was but decided to discard his identity and identified with a lifestyle and a behavior that was riotous. He lived and acted as if he was not related to the father. His behavior showed no knowledge of his father and he ceased to fulfill the purpose God intended for his life. The world system, which he aligned himself to, performed a form of "identity theft" over his life leaving him homeless and to panhandling for food. Finally, the prodigal son remembered his identity and returned to his father. Have you experienced either example of identity crisis (naturally or spiritually)?

What really motivates our lifestyle and behavior arises of the fact that we have forgotten who we are or lost our identity? Is our experience connected in a foreign land and not 'in Christ'? Is our conduct a by-product of the association to the ways and attitudes of our environment? Like Jason and the prodigal son, we must recapture our identity to remember we have a home in glory; and God has a good plan for our lives (Jer 29:11). We must remember the words of the Apostle Paul as he declared that we are dead yet we are alive 'in Christ' (Gal 2:20). We have been bought with a price and placed 'in Christ' (1 Cor 6:20). We must remember that we were born again into a royal family by the will of God (Rom 11:17). We must remember that we are new creations in Christ Jesus; that we are joint heirs with Jesus to all the blessings God has stored up for us (Ps 16:11; Rom 8:17), and our identity is hid in Christ Jesus our Lord and Savior.

Like Jason and the prodigal son, the restoring of our identity is in our relationship to the Father and 'in Christ'. We bear His name, His likeness, and our lives are a reflection of the love and the authority we have 'in Christ'. Your identity 'in Christ' is all the identification you need to re-strain the enemy, re-establish your relationship with the Father and re-store a LifeLock on your Kingdom authority.

Identity In Christ

Iwonder how many of us remember the movie "Spartacus", originally released back in 1960. It was a powerful and passionate production about slavery and roman superiority.

In 73 BCE, a slave named Spartacus led a revolt at a gladiatorial school. The uprising soon spreads across the Italian Peninsula involving thousands of slaves. They planned to acquire sufficient funds to buy ships from pirates who could then transport them to other lands and down to southern Italy. A Roman Senator schemes to have a Commander of the garrison of Rome, lead an army against the slaves who are living in hiding in the country's forests. When the Commander is defeated his mentor, Senator and General, Marcus Licinius Crassus is embarrassed and leads his own army against the slaves.

Spartacus and the thousands of freed slaves successfully make their way to Brandisium only to find that the pirates have abandoned them. They then turn north and must face the might of Rome. Spartacus and his army discover that they are surrounded by three Roman armies led by Crassus. In the final battle, the slaves, after a fierce struggle, are routed, and slaughtered by the thousands. The few thousand survivors, including Spartacus, are taken to Rome to be crucified.

In one of the most memorable scenes in the movie, a roman soldier bellows out a decree; "The Commander of Italy Marcus Licinius Crassus so orders your lives will be spared, slaves you were, and slaves you will remain. The penalty of crucifixion will be set aside under one condition. You must identify the slave called Spartacus". Suddenly one by one the beaten slaves turned warrior, back to slaves again stood up all claiming to be Spartacus. None of them could even consider turning

their back on the one person who offered them hope and freedom. All willing to die free rather than live in slavery. How can anyone deny shedding a tear after watching such conviction?

As followers of Christ we too must stand up with that same conviction and resist wavering to the left or the right when faced with the decision of following Christ and doing what we understand to be right in the sight of our God. When we made the conscious decision to turn away from our old ways and trust in God, that's when we became transformed to take on our new identity as Kingdom men and women. (Luke 17: 20) To walk, talk, and act with the confidence, knowing God will never leave us nor forsake us as long as we seek his counsel (Pray regularly), and follow his blue print for living (Read the Bible) while we exist in this world.

Jesus made the model for us to follow. (Matthew 26:63-64) When Caiaphas, the high priest of the Sanhedrin charged Jesus under oath to tell them if he is the Christ, the Son of God. With children and adults going back to school in the fall, many schools require immunizations to be up to date in order to enroll. The purpose of Immunization Awareness Month is to promote the benefits of immunization.

Immunization is touted as one of the most significant public health achievements of the 20th century. It is thought to have begun in 17th or 18th century and was believed to be initially focused on the eradication of small pox. Thankfully it worked! Vaccines have eradicated small pox, polio and greatly decreased the number of individuals who get measles, diphtheria, rubella, whooping cough and other diseases. Rotary International continues to do amazing work in this area and recently has publicized its work to eradicate polio.

It is important to have everyone vaccinated, especially children and older adults, in order to ensure healthy lives. There are many nonprofit organizations that provide immunization information including institutions that administer "free vaccinations" and concerns about vaccines. A simple search on the Internet will often produce information about where to get vaccinated in your community. Additionally, check with the Center for Disease Control's website,

which provides details about a vaccination schedule and other pertinent information.

Also remember, when you go to the doctor regularly you not only keep up to date on your vaccines, but also on your health in general. Most regular check-ups start with a blood draw. Doctors can screen for a lot of things based on your blood draw and can catch disease in early stages when this is done regularly. This simple step can save a life and improve the health of the community.

Here are five (5) recommendations and tips on the importance of immunization that will Make A Difference (M.A.D.):

1. The purpose of Immunization Awareness Month in August is to promote the benefits of immunization; check with your family, both young and old, to make sure everyone is immunized.
2. Create a chart to track the immunizations of all family members including children, parents and grandparents; check it annually.
3. Organize a health fair in your community for screenings, immunizations and bone marrow donor tests!
4. Check out the CDC website for tips and recommendations
5. Make a financial contribution to a nonprofit organization focused on insuring that the most vulnerable in our society, children and older adults, are vaccinated. A nonprofit organization doing amazing work in this area is the Immunization Action Coalition.

Bonus Tip: Contact your local public health department for additional information. They are a great resource in your community! You can find yours by going to www.hhs.gov/about/.

By working together and insuring all who need to be vaccinated, we will be making our immediate communities and world healthier. We will truly be Making A Difference!

Prayer: Genesis 4:26

**'Seth also had a son, and he named him Enoch.
At that time people began to call on the name of the Lord.'**

Our Bishop Merton L. Clark is a true Man of God and the Women of Word, Worship and Warfare are truly grateful and consider it an honor and privilege every time we are able to sit and get his undivided attention. He reminded us that we are Women of Worship which we displayed earlier on that beautiful Saturday morning. We are Women of Word, which we were reminded of on the following day during the 8/1 I am services. Finally, but certainly not least, we are Women of Warfare. Bishop Clark was very clear as to what was going to take place next...a charging of our faith, tenacity, fight, courage, bravery and intercession. He activated intercession on the inside of us to talk to God. We can talk to each other, in fact we should be talking with each other, but we can't forget to talk to God. If we start having a conversation with God, there is a pretty good guarantee that He will talk back to us.

Morning Devotions: Mark 1:35

"Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed"

Mother's WOW Women it's time to rise up early in the morning. Don't forget your family prayer time. This can't and shouldn't be rushed, we need to remember and do like our grandmothers did. Rising up in the morning communing with the Lord. Our children need to see us retire early for bed, so we are the first ones up the next morning praying over the house. For we know that Satan is called the son of the morning and who ever rules the morning is lord over our day. We can defeat him in the morning hours by talking to God and praying for our family. Remember that whatever we are witnessing in the society is tied to a lack of prayer. Whatever we are witnessing in our family/children is tied to not praying. We must recognize that God can speak to them just like He did with Samuel. 1 Samuel 3:1 - The boy Samuel ministered before the Lord under Eli. In those days the word of the Lord was rare; there were not many visions"

As the church we have to pray, because we don't want to be like Eli, who spent time with God then lost his ability to hear from the Lord. That means cutting the tv off, not leaving it on while you sleep. Because our minds and ears are still active as we sleep. When we worry we slice our eternal self up, we have lots of scar tissue and no feeling; just doing what we want, when we want and not caring. When we get rid of worry we keep ourselves healthier on the inside, this will allow the 'Master' to touch us from the inside out and say that He doesn't want us to be doing these crazy things and something on the inside of us will yeild to the 'Father'.

Morning and Evening is our time to talk to God. Bishop wants the WOW Women to pray for him, his family, the church family, the move of the next dimension. The Lord is telling our Bishop that its time to pray. The enemy is attacking the people of God. We must lift up our voices and open up our mouths and intercede and talk to God like our grandmothers used to do. If we want God to take care of our children, we need to send our prayers into the future. We need to raise up the wall ladies, for we are the wall when we stand together in prayer.

I would first like to extend my utmost gratitude for taking the time to consider me for your scholarship investment. This process as an involvement and investment of your time, efforts, and consideration, and is duly noted. If selected, I plan to use these funds to finance my education at Stanford University, where I plan to dual major in Economics and Business Administration or Political Science.

Principles are what bind a person to their moral compass. They keep them on track to the goals they set for themselves, and alert them whenever they stray off course. And for as complicated a period of time as college is and will be, the principles that will keep me grounded and focused are two-fold and relatively simple.

The first, and personally the more crucial of the two principles, is humility. Though both are equally important, pride is what can elevate or destroy a person in the eyes of God. Early on in my spiritual education, it was drilled into me that pride was the sin God loathed above all others. Wisdom is a product of humility and humility is of God, but Pride will tell a prince he is above God and force his hand into foolish action. Getting into Stanford was a dream accomplished and was a huge step in itself, but it isn't my final goal. I have to continue to be diligent and focused and work to position myself for Christ to keep elevating me. But, the driving force in all of these plans is my humility. Among all and any more praise I may receive for what people perceive that I have done, I have to reroute it back to Christ and continue to keep him first. The minute I don't is when he hands me the keys to a car I can't control, and a crash will be inevitable.

The second of the principles that will keep me focused during my college career is trust. Going hand in hand with humility, trust is giving the burden of what you can't control to God for him to handle. Again, this holds personal significance to me. I've had to master this principle starting at age 12, when my arthritis startled both my mother and me. Having to work through that pain and process with no end in sight, it wasn't but a year later that my mom got cancer, and I had to trust that God was going to bring both of us through our trials. Starting out ninth grade, I had dreams of going to Stanford specifically, but midway through it I convinced myself (and did everything in my own power to prove) that I couldn't do it. Now, as I'm staring down the barrel of an incredibly difficult college career and climb up the corporate ladder, I have no excuse but to trust God. Time and time again he's proven that his plan is greater than my worries, and now I feel confident that, provided I remain humble and trusting in Him, I'll remain focused and successful in college.


INTERCESSION, THE WELL OF VISION


1. Recognize/Admit That You Are a Sinner,




